SLPTU renewed SurveyMonkey subscription.

Membership Report: Andy Walsh

Some apprentice teachers are now eligible to join SLPTU. Membership is at 89% of teachers in the district. Anyone who joins SLPTU now, will not have to pay dues to SLPTU or EdMN until the fall. Potential members can sign up online or via a paper copy.

President's Report: Scott Smith

SLPTU is partnering with EdMN to sponsor a Get Out the Vote (GotV) initiative next fall. SLPTU's GotV lead is Matt Meier. SLPTU will be holding union events to encourage members to vote for pro-education representatives this fall. Work-site Action Leads (WALs) will help from each building. There will be a short training in May for WALs. Education MN has funding for GotV events.

Education Minnesota:

Building Reports:

<u>EC/ABE</u> - Still working on preschool negotiations.

<u>CV</u> - No report at this time.

<u>NP</u> - Showcase of Learning is on Carnival night. The expectation is classrooms are all set up and teachers volunteer for 2 hour shifts. This is a change from past practice. A Resident teacher model will replace the Apprentice Teacher. Instead of multi age classes, teachers will now loop with their students.

<u>PT</u> - Escalating student behaviors and misplaced students.

WCSI - Nothing to report.

<u>WW 5-6</u> - Ongoing discussions regarding the expectation that members stay to help support a PTO lock-in on a Friday evening. This is a change from past practice. Sub model will continue the same next year.

<u>WW 7-8</u> - Some members have expressed a need for equity in the sub model for all teachers – rotations continuing for next year.

<u>HS</u> - Inconsistencies with behavior support and student consequences. Increased evenings of time requirements outside of the work day. Some conversation around staff attendance at graduation.
